CODE OF CONDUCT

We are grateful that you take the time to familiarise yourselves with this Code of Conduct in order to ensure the smooth running of this activity in a convivial atmosphere.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT



I will wear an approved bicycle helmet at all times.

I will wear easily-visible clothing and have a rear light on my bike. 



I will make sure that my bicycle is in good working order before participating in the event.

RESPECT FOR THE TRAFFIC RULES ON TRACK



I will cycle in the track direction (clockwise).

I will pass only on the left and will leave the left side of the track open to the fastest participants. 




I will stop only in the (grass or tarmac) areas off-track and maintain a predictable path for other participants.

RESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOUR



I will adopt responsible and respectful behaviour towards other participants.

I will not cycle under the influence of alcohol or illicit substances. 




The Circuit is monitored by a camera via the track security post, and any dangerous behaviour by yourself or other participants will be reported.

COMMUNICATION



I will use clear signals to indicate my intentions to other participants, such as by using my voice or by appropriate gestures.

When the warning signs are lit on the track (red colour), I will end my lap and leave the track (following the "track exit" arrows). 

IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT



If I am the witness or victim of an accident, I will stop and alert the track safety staff if necessary (+32 (0)87 29 37 26). Our medical team will come to bring assistance to the victim and will administer first aid.

RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT



I will not throw any litter on the Circuit and will respect all waste-sorting instructions.

RESPECT FOR THE FACILITIES



I will respect the Circuit's facilities and will not cause any intentional damage to them.

RESPECT FOR OTHER USERS OF THE CIRCUIT



The Circuit's paddocks are occupied by other users besides Cycl'On Track participants, including cars. Cycling activities can only take place on the track. Respect for the rules of the road is in order away from the track.
